WATER DEPARTMENT

PCPWA has asked us to remind you that if you will call them and ask to be put on the call list, you will be notified when your water is going to be turned off to take care of repairs. The cost for this service is a one-time charge of \$1 then a monthly fee of .25 cents. But it assures you of a call when at all possible.

There were three major breaks in Arrowhead this past month. One of them had a secondary break in which it became necessary to immediately turn the water off for the entire area. A call was placed as soon as possible to those who had the service. Their phone number is on the monthly bill.
